Serving the community since the late 1800s, our public school district is separate from Sisters School District and operates independently. The District is governed by a five-member Board of Directors, which sets the direction for the school according to our Mission and Vision and adopts policies to support those goals.

The volunteer Board of Directors meets monthly on the second Tuesday, with additional meetings as needed. Meetings are open to the public. As elected officials, members are full-time residents and registered voters within the Black Butte School District, who can run for open Board positions after one year of residency.
