Position: Licensed Teacher- Upper Grades (5-8 grades)

Job Purpose Statement:

To effectively promote the growth and development of students through a hands-on, place-based and project-based education program. Specific subject areas include Math, English-Language Arts, Social Studies and other subjects depending on strengths.

Required Education and Experiences:

1. Current Oregon Teaching License with appropriate endorsement and authorization for the assignment or the ability to earn or transfer a license before the start date
2. Experience working with children in grades K-8, especially grades 5-8.
3. Experience in mixed grade settings preferred
4. Current basic First Aid and CPR certification
5. A minimum of 4 years classroom teaching experience preferred
6. Experience teaching students in both formal classroom environments and more informal experiential settings.

Required Skills and Dispositions:

1. Knowledge of and skill in implementing curriculum and positive classroom management techniques
2. Knowledge of and skill in building a cohesive relationship with students, families, and district employees
